The news must be original and its publication has been approved by all the co-authors, if any, as well as by the responsible authorities – tacitly or explicitly – at the institute or organization where the work has been carried out. The publisher will not be legally responsible for any claims of originality by other organization.

## **Types of Manuscripts**

The Newsletter is inviting for promising technology, basic and strategic research, promising genotype, new methodology, event related to vegetable (Conference, symposium, brainstorming, farmer's fair, etc.), novel finding, innovative concept, groundbreaking vegetable photograph.

Following are the limits of text, figures and tables in manuscript:

Text word limit: 300-800

Total number of figures, including picture: not more than four

Total number of tables: not more than two

### **Illustrations Guidelines**

Image used in article should be original. It should not be from internet or other source. It should have clear view and dense pixel with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.

### **Text Formatting**

Manuscripts should submitted in Word file through be e-mail (vegetablenewsletter@gmail.com).

- Use a normal, plain font (e.g., 12-point Times New Roman) for text.
- Use italics for emphasis and vernacular names like *Petha*.
- Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.
- Use the table function, not spreadsheets, to make tables.
- Use the equation editor or Math Type for equations.
- Save your file in docx format (Word 2007 or higher) or doc format (older Word versions).

# **Rule of Plagiarism**

Authors are advised to strictly follow the rule of plagiarism. The write-up should not copy of other research article.
